



ECOHERB

TECHNICAL INFORMATION:

EcoHerb is a broad spectrum, systemic, non-selective foliar herbicide which provides excellent control of broadleaf and grassy weeds. It can be used as desiccant in cotton and potatoes. Warm temperatures and bright sunlight improve the performance of **EcoHerb**.

Apply **EcoHerb** only on growing weeds whose height does not exceed 20 cm.

To maximise weed control is recommended not to cultivate the treated soil 7 days after application.

MODE OF ACTION:

- **EcoHerb** inhibits the synthesis of some essential amino acids for chlorophyll formation and root development.
- **EcoHerb** moves from the leaves through the plant into the roots giving an immediate effect, i.e. wilting, yellowing, etc within, visible in a very short period of time.

RECOMMENDATIONS OF USE:

- **EcoHerb** should be used by mixing one litre in one litre of water.
- Good leaf coverage is essential for optimum weed control.
- It does not have any residual activity in soil.
- Avoid drift onto adjacent crops and other no target areas.

DOSAGE:

- The dosage is 10 litres per Ha.

APPLICATION EQUIPMENT:

- **EcoHerb** is a specific formulation to be applied with CDA (Controlled Droplet application) sprayer.

COMPATIBILITY:

- **EcoHerb** should be used alone without mixing with any other pesticide or fertilizer.
- **EcoHerb** can not be reformulated.

CAUTIONS:

- Shake well before use.
- Keep out of reach of children.

STORAGE:

- **EcoHerb** must be kept in its original properly labelled container well sealed and stored in a cool, dry and ventilated place.

PRESENTATION:

- Packs of 100, 250, 500 ml, 1, 5, 20, 100, 200 and 1000 liters.
